- 3. Bank account information. A BDO account is preferred. However, accounts from other banks and GCash may also be used. Please make absolutely sure account information is correct. Incorrect information will cause delay in receiving stipends.**
- 4. Essay in print. A hand-written essay will not be accepted.**
- 5. Frontal Photo: In uniform, half-body with white background.**
- 6. Letter of Recommendation from Teacher or School Administrator**
- 7. Letter of Recommendation from Community Leader or Organization (Barangay, Church, or School)**
- 8. Proof of Household Income (See Financial Information Requirements)**
- 9. Submit each required item as a separate attachment. Do not embed one item within another document. You may submit all required items in a single email, but each must be attached individually and not combined into a single file. Links to online platforms will not be accepted.**

ANI Scholarship Program Terms & Conditions

By accepting this scholarship from the ANI Scholarship Program (hereafter ANI), you agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. **Purpose of Scholarship:** This scholarship is to be used **exclusively for educational expenses**, which may include tuition, fees, books, and other directly related school activities and supplies at **Quezon Science High School (QueSci)**.
2. **Enrollment Requirement:** You must remain **enrolled and in good standing** at QueSci for the entire **School Year 2027-2028**. ANI may request proof of enrollment at any time.
3. **Academic Progress & Report Cards:** Although this is a needs based scholarship with no strict grade cutoff, ANI expects you to make a good faith effort in your studies and maintain satisfactory academic progress as defined by QueSci.

You must submit a copy of your report card each reporting period within seven (7) calendar days of its release by QueSci to all ANI Officers. Your stipend for the month when report cards are released will be issued only after all ANI Officers receive your report card.

If you are unable to obtain or submit your report card within this period for a valid reason, you must notify the ANI Officers in accordance with TC 8 before the deadline, explain the circumstances, and provide an expected date of submission. ANI may grant an extension at its discretion.

4. **Non-Transferability:** This scholarship is awarded solely to you. It may not be transferred to another student or to another school.
5. **Reporting Changes:** You must promptly inform ANI of any changes to your enrollment status, academic standing, or financial situation that may affect your eligibility.
6. **Publicity:** By accepting this scholarship, you grant ANI permission to use your name and likeness in ANI promotional materials (e.g., website, social media, annual report) to celebrate your achievement and support ANI's mission. If you prefer not to be included in publicity materials, you may opt out by notifying ANI in writing.



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7. **Stipend Receipt Confirmation:** ANI will disburse stipends during the first week of each month. ANI's Treasurer will inform the scholars via the group chat in Messenger when stipends have been sent. You must immediately report receipt non-receipt of your stipend. This helps ANI determine if disbursements of stipends are successful. Conversely, prompt reporting of non-receipt of stipends allows ANI to address issues immediately.
8. **Communication & Response Time:** To ensure smooth coordination and continued support, you must respond promptly to all communications from ANI sent via email or Messenger.

ANI will specify a response deadline, **typically three (3) business days**. If you need more time, you must request an extension before the deadline and provide a new expected date.

Failure to respond on time may affect your stipend and may result in reduction or forfeiture.

9. **Year-End Requirements:** In addition to submitting report cards and certificates, the scholars as a group must recruit incoming scholars for the next school year. The goal is for the scholars to work as one group or in small groups to engender camaraderie or esprit de corps. The number of recruits will be determined by the number of graduating seniors. The application period goes from December 1 of the current year through March 1 of the following year.

Each graduating senior must also submit an exit essay similar to the application essay. It must be at least 500-1000 words. It must describe what ANI has meant to them and how ANI helped them achieve their educational goals.

10. **Event Participation & Safety Acknowledgment:** Parents/guardians acknowledge that their child's participation in ANI activities – including, but not limited to, the annual Scholars' Dinner – is voluntary. They understand that normal risks may arise during travel to and from the venue and during attendance at the event. By allowing their child to participate, parents/guardians agree that ANI, its organizers, and volunteers are not liable for injuries or incidents arising from ordinary risks, provided ANI has exercised reasonable care.
